The young wife, a believer, had invited me to come visit her unbelieving husband. The incident with the motorcycle had occurred the morning of the day of my visit.


As I witnessed about Christ, he said, "If God wants me to know Him, why doesn't He do something dramatic in my life?"

#### FIGHT YOUR FEARS

God does not wish for people to be cowards; fear is a crippling, not an empowering, emotion. Dr. David Jeremiah states in <u>What Are You Afraid Of</u>, "... fear is the tyrant of the imagination." He also quotes Neil T. Anderson, "Phobias are like the coils of a snake – the more we give in to them, the tighter they squeeze." How true this is; our fears constrict our ability to act, or even hope!

I recall a news article years ago about a boy who was perhaps 6 years old, who was being constricted by a snake. Rather than flail or fail by succumbing to the fear of immanent death, the boy got angry – and began to bite the snake! He used his brain, and his mouth, to inflict pain on his attacker, and the snake let him go! The boy decided that it was time to use a tactic of a snake against a snake, and it saved his life.

In my life I have often gotten tough with myself and mentally reprimanded, "No self-pity trips!" This has helped shake me out of lethargy and suffocating gloominess. Likewise, when confronted by fear one of the best things you can do is confront it head on, in prayer and attitude. I recall Paul's bolstering a young pastor, Timothy, who felt overwhelmed in his calling, "... God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline (2 Timothy 1:7)." If we do not adopt the attitude of victor, we easily become victims.
