I saw a listing of the "Habits of Chronically Unhappy People" which I thought I would share:

- 1. Complaining
- 2. Staying home
- 3. Ignoring Problems
- 4. Constantly looking to the future
- 5. Not improving
- 6. Seeing self as victim
- 7. Trying to keep up with neighbors
- 8. Blowing things out of proportion
- 9. Pessimism
- 10. Spending too much time acquiring stuff

Some of these "habits" may be unavoidable, such as a stay at home mom not getting out socializing, or a person who was raped or robbed feeling like a victim. We all have intrusions and burdens to bear. However, many things on this list are *habitual*. In Christ we should not be habitually exercising the attitudes and behaviors on this list.

HOW DEATH IS DEFEATED

The Apostle Peter, preaching the first recorded Christian sermon in the New Testament following Christ's resurrection, highlights the fact that, "...God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him (2:24)." Peter was alluding to the truth that death only operates on sinful people, and since Christ is sin-free death could not retain its grip on him.

Jesus took upon himself our guilt and carried it to the cross, where he fully paid for our sins and mediated for us before the Father. Once that had been done, death was *incapable* of holding him in the grave. Death operates by sin, and sin convicts us because of God's law, his holy will, which we have broken. However, when we are attributed Jesus' righteousness, then we, too, have victory over the grave. The final fix for us is when this sin infested body is done away with, to be remade at the resurrection. At that time death will have nothing to act upon us!
