"CAN THESE BONES LIVE?"

When the Lord wanted to encourage the Israelites who were captive in Babylon following the exile due to their sins, he gave the prophet Ezekiel a profound vision of a multitude of dry bones coming together and vivifying to form living people, an army for God. Prior to this demonstration the Lord inquired of Ezekiel, "Can these bones live (v.3)?" Ezekiel answered, "O sovereign Lord, only you know."

What a wise response from Ezekiel! He avoided the two classic blunders, distrusting in God's power, which he would have revealed if he had answered in the negative, or displaying arrogant over-confidence, perhaps insinuating himself into the process, if he answered in the affirmative. I do not think Ezekiel was hedging his bets, but rather humbly subjugating his mind to the Lord's.

Our God holds the power of resurrection, the power of life over death. Do you believe it? Do you believe that he can make your bones rise again? In Christ we are able to state a more vigorous, "Amen," as opposed to a feebler, "only you know."


BUILD UP YOUR CHILDREN, AND GUARD THEIR SOCIAL IDENTITY!

Purportedly a new "suicide game" targeting teens is making its way around the world. It is called Blue Whale and is, "a social media game that has "curators" who target players between 10 and 14 years old. The curators push the kids to do a list of pained tasks including waking up in the middle of night, cutting themselves, and ultimately committing suicide. Those who get scared and attempt to leave the game received threats including suggestion that their parents will be killed.

The Cyberbullying Research Center believes Blue Whale is a hoax, but parents should be watchful what their teens are doing online and in social media. One tried and true method is to be part of their social network, the equivalent of checking their room at home. Watch for sudden, intense shifts in behavior or use of technology; it may mean something controlling is going on. Make sure, too, to reinforce your love for them, and set them an example of Godliness by being faithful in worship and Scripture reading/study, so you don't look like a hypocrite when you say they are required to do the same.
