#### **KEY CHAPTERS OF THE BIBLE: OLD TESTAMENT**

#### "TURN THE OTHER CHEEK IS DEAD"

That was the title of my recent sermon exploring how there seems to be a shift toward revenge, and legally Stand Your Ground laws have been passed in many states. An alternative named the Castle Doctrine or Castle Law, is also being enacted in many states. The upshot is that one can now legally respond with force, and if necessary kill. The law of a country is not often in perfect harmony with our faith, and in some cases it is not in harmony with faith. The Christian is called to a higher standard than upholding the law. Jesus told his followers, "You have heard it said, 'Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth.' But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If someone strikes you on the right cheek, turn to him the other also (see Matthew 5:38-42 and Luke 6:27-36)." Among all the teachings of Jesus I find some of the strongest resistance on this point from believers. It seems we feel self-defense is part of the Gospel, but it is not. Jesus is totally pacifistic, to an extreme degree. He calls his people to a radical love not known by the world. Christians may have opposing opinions on this topic due to conscience. Some feel strongly that they must oppose evil if necessary, especially to protect others. Some believers feel that no violence is ever condoned. It is good to wrestle with such topics and pray about them. Our culture seems to be "hardening" in that resistance to the point of killing is finding more acceptance, while showing extreme love through forbearance is declining.

## SURGERY AT 90!

It is not that uncommon anymore to hear of persons 90 years old having major surgery! Recently one of our elder members fell, broke her hip, had surgery to replace the ball of the hip joint, and within a week is up and walking! How marvelous that the Lord has allowed mankind to use the incredible genius granted in our minds to develop modern medicine! Jesus was the one to shift the emphasis on the sick and dying from disdain to compassion. The ancient world tried to get rid of the sick and handicapped. Jesus taught his followers compassion for the sick. An explosion of hospitals and care ministries came from the example of Christ. Millions have given their lives in Christian service to care for those injured on battlefields, brought down by accidents and illness, and struggling with addictions or other mental health infirmities.
