DRUGGED CULTURE

Millennials are more interested in smoking pot than drinking beer. This has the alcoholic beverage makers in a spot. If recreational marijuana use becomes legal, we are in serious trouble as a country. If that happens, expect a cascade of unfavorable political figures and laws to invade our republic. We are seeing the decline of American culture right before our eyes, primarily due to indifference toward God and covetousness that seeks to leach off the government and pay no heed to the price that future generations will pay for the excesses of today.

This is no surprise, however, to the student of the Bible, which teaches that *all cultures* are inherently skewed toward the sinful flesh, even the Israelite community that so displeased the Lord in the Wilderness. The Lord raised the Jews to conquer the Canaanites of the Promised Land not because the Jews were so good, but because the Canaanites were far worse! Note the commentary of the Lord regarding the Jews as they were set on the course to occupy Canaan, "... do not say to yourself, 'The Lord has brought me here to take possession of this land because of my righteousness.' No, it is on account of the wickedness of these nations that the Lord is going to drive them out before you (Deuteronomy 9:4)."

Hundreds of years later this very people group had become corrupted, secularized, and condemnable just as the Canaanites whom they vanquished generations before. The only reason the Lord spared the Jews was to bring forth the world's Messiah, Jesus, since he had made an absolute promise to do so. Let us not be surprised, then, to see our culture disintegrate, as have all others historically. Cultures rise and fall like weeds, but thankfully the Kingdom of Christ prevails. If America were to fall, the Lord could transform a different land that would use the template of America's history to establish a state with freedoms and liberties similar to what we enjoy. The seeds of such a transformation are already sown in places such as China, India and South America.

Heed the call of the Holy Spirit, "See to it, brothers, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God. But encourage each other daily, as long as it is called *today*, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness (Hebrews 3:12-13)."
